



Application for a grant from the EFCD Scientific Foundation

The application for funding must contain the following:

1. **Recipient**

- Name, given name
- Academic title
- Institution
- Address of Institution
- Phone, Fax, e-mail
- Professional CV
- List of Publications (categorized into scientific original research, overviews and continuing education papers)
- List of presentations (categorized into scientific presentations and continuing education presentations and courses)

2. **Precise description of the Project to be funded**

- The project must be scientifically justified including a short explanation of preliminary work and some working hypotheses (as in a thesis). The material and methods of the planned experiments must be described, including a schedule/time frame and the budgeted expenses. (If possible expenses should be substantiated with offers from suppliers). If the Declaration of Helsinki requires a statement of the Ethical Committee (animal research, clinical studies), it must be included into the application. If the application is for partial funding only, then the other sources of funding must be named (include application/or notification).
- Letter(s) of acceptance by the institution(s) where the project will be performed.
- Location of where the project will be executed, (justify the choice).
- Travel and lodging expenses

3. **Amount of required funding**

Include a detailed budget of the complete project. (The more precise the budget is, the more competent it may be evaluated)

4. **Statement**
